Transportation Advisory Committee Charge & Charter
September, 2007

- I. CHARGE** To research, develop and continually revise a student transportation agenda, including a list of shortcomings and proposed solutions, to be approved by the A.S. Board of Directors. To promote, publicize and solicit feedback on said agenda among the students of WWU. To work to implement the agenda on behalf of the A.S. To maintain communication with all major transportation decision-making bodies; including, but not limited to the Transportation Planning Initiatives Task Force, Whatcom Transportation Authority and the City of Bellingham. To critically evaluate and report on methods and decisions of said bodies, with respect to student interests.
- II. MEMBERSHIP**
- A.S. Vice President for Student Life, Chair
 - A.S. Vice President for Legislative and Governmental Affairs, Vice-Chair
 - A.S. Student Alternative Transportation Coordinator
 - 1 – Student Senator, appointed by the Student Senate
 - 1- Student from the Residence Hall Association, appointed by R.H.A.
 - 4- Students-at-large, appointed by the A.S. Board of Directors (more at-large positions may be added for content and value)
 - Advisor, non-voting
- III. CHAIR** The Chairperson shall be the A.S. Vice President for Student Life. (S)he shall convene the meetings, approve agendas, and preside at all meetings. The Vice-Chairperson shall be the Vice President for Legislative and Governmental Affairs and acts in the absence of the Chair.
- IV. MEETINGS** The committee shall meet at least once per month, when called upon by the Chair. Meetings shall be called by the Chair with a minimum of forty-eight (48) hours' notice. Any member may call a meeting when requested by twenty-five percent (25%) of the seated, voting membership.
- V. VOTING** The committee shall follow all procedures indicated in the Bylaws.
- VI. QUORUM** A majority of the voting membership seated shall constitute a quorum. If a quorum is not present, the Chair will adjourn the meeting and reschedule to a new day and hour.
- VII. AMENDMENTS** This charter may be amended by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the committee and a majority of the A.S. Board of Directors.
- VIII. BYLAWS** The committee may adopt Bylaws governing its operation by a two-thirds (2/3) vote of the seated, voting membership.
- IX. REPORTAGE** The committee shall report through the office of the A.S. Vice President for Student Life to the A.S. Board of Directors and the University Administration.
