I. Summary/Recommendations

The VU 50th Anniversary Event Committee, consisting of Aaron Garcia, Virgilio Cintron, Casey Hayden, Cindy Monger, and Keri Wienbrecht, Met on Friday, July 24th 2009. The following are some recommendations from the committee:

- 1) Decade Days
 - a) We recommend switching "decade day" from November 2nd-6th to October 26th-30th
 - i) We feel students would be more apt to dress up for the decade days leading up to Halloween. Student will be more willing to get into the spirit
 - b) If students dress-up or turn in something into the time capsule they will be given a chance to win a prize(Something big, Video Game console, IPod,Etc) , we can announce the prize during the AS Bookstore annual Costume Contest
- 2) Time Capsule
 - a) There should be a place on the VU 6th floor for people to turn in Time Capsule

- 3) VU Halloween Dance
